Found this in the old box...

"Looks like a Type 1a..."



Easy peasey.

Attributes easy to see:



"Good. Scott 500... Sold!"

Could it be real?

Ahh! I see...



- Special printing and not regularly issued
- Gum on the majority of stamps without "Specimen" overprint was disturbed
- 2017 Scott Specialized: \$85,000.00
- Sale no. <u>1180</u> Lot no. <u>298</u> <u>2018-04-11</u>



No! Look again! This one!

Wait a minute... It's USED!

Does it even exist?

Let's look at the catalog!


- "Specimens... Back section of catalog
- Not a "Used" stamp
- Specimen" often "erased" to mimic unused stamp
- Genuine Specimen

Fake Specimen





"TT IS NOT SCOTT 296a, RATHER IT IS A PREVIOUSLY HINGED SCOTT 296Sa, WITH THE "SPECIMEN" LIGHTENED, A SMALL SEALED TEAR AT UPPER LEFT, AN ADDED PERFORATION AT BOTTOM, AND REPERFORATED AT TOP."




Took it to -

- Dealer Friends said it looks "Good!"
- USSS Friends said it looks "Good!"
- Expertiser Friend said it looks "Good!"
- Get it Certified...

Good News!



Ding! Ding! Ding!

If it's too good to be true...

It probably is!

Genuine 296 Fake "Patient"

- Red flags... We see a scrape on the vignette.
- Why is it taking so long? (The owner is...)
- "This is a <u>Serious</u> stamp!"
- We need to test it with the VSC-6000
- After four months and probably six reviews:

Bad News!

IT IS NOT SCOTT 296a, RATHER, IT IS A SCOTT 296, WITH ORIGINAL VIGNETTE REMOVED, THEN FRAUDULENTLY PLACED BACK TO SIMULATE A 4¢ PAN AMERICAN INVERT.





Could we have saved some time and money?



No details on address side







- "I found this on eBay" BTW...
 - "Ask the Seller a Question"
 - 1. Will he take "Buy It Now?
 - 2. Character analysis
 - 3. Knowledgeable?
- You just paid for your week, next year!
- I wonder if this might be an early date?
- Research, research!

I really can't decipher the cancel.

Seller says it looks like 1918, confirmed by "another bidder."





If it is possibly 1913, it would be a First Day Cover. Photoshop high contrast – no help.

Closely –
at the
Whole
Tag!

Another cancel!



Take a Favorite Stamp Variety

- "On Special Paper" Variety
- 2017 Scott: Not Listed (\$450 *)
- 2016 Durland: \$2,000
- 2018 Hebert PNS: \$1,000
- Measurably Different from Sheet
 Stamps on Regular Paper

Old "Technology" Paper Cutouts



Scott E13 Lot on eBay

- Print the Image
- Cut Out One as a Template
- Compare the rest
- If All are the Same:
 - Probably <u>Not</u> the Rarity
 - But Maybe SBP!












